This new book by a local author takes the reader on a journey around the extensive railway infrastructure that has served Selby for almost two hundred years, examining the growth and contraction of its lines and rail traffic. The author examines the many changes to the track, the trains and their customers which once radiated from the town, including nine pages which feature Riccall itself. With 200 pages, more than 260 colour and black-and-white photographs, twenty-seven maps, diagrams and drawings - 95% of which have never been published before - this illustrated narrative provides the most comprehensive exploration to date of the railways of Selby.
